FROM KAREN ROWE:

The Burning Bush and Our Lord, Jesus Christ

God reveals himself to Moisés in the burning bush. When Moses sees this spectacular event, he goes to investigate. This bush burns but is not consumed, a manifestation of a divine Being. God reveals His holy name, I Am. (Yahweh)

In the New Testament, Christ reveals Himself with "I Am" seven times. Some examples include:

I am the bread of life

I am the light of the world,

I am the way, the truth, and the life

I am the resurrection and the life

But the burning bush also points directly to Christ. The bush is not destroyed by the fire. Christ, through His Incarnation, is fully divine without consuming or obliterating it: Jesus Christ was fully human while remaining fully divine. Fire came to the bush without destroying it.

The burning bush thus further illuminates for us how the Incarnation was God's full manifestation to us. The fullness of divinity dwelled with the fullness of humanity. Is this not what happens at Mass when the bread and wine are changed into the Body and Blood? The Eucharist still appears to be bread and wine, but through the miracle of transubstantiation, we have the Real Presence of Christ.

Let us pay attention to how God will reveal Himself to you and come and worship Him at Mass.

La zarza ardiente y nuestro Señor Jesucristo

Dios se revela a Moisés en la zarza ardiente. Cuando Moisés ve este evento espectacular, va a investigar. Este arbusto arde pero no se consume, una manifestación de un Ser divino. Dios revela Su santo nombre, Yo Soy. (Yahweh)

En el Nuevo Testamento, Cristo se revela a sí mismo con "Yo Soy" siete veces. Algunos ejemplos incluyen:

Yo soy el pan de vida

Yo soy la luz del mundo,

Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida

Yo soy la resurrección y la vida

Pero la zarza ardiente también apunta directamente a Cristo. El arbusto no es destruido por el fuego. Cristo, a través de Su Encarnación, es completamente divino sin consumiéndola o borrándola: Jesucristo era completamente humano sin dejar de ser completamente divino.

Fuego

llegó al monte sin destruirlo.

De este modo, la zarza ardiente nos ilumina aún más cómo la Encarnación fue la plena manifestación de Dios para nosotros. La plenitud de la divinidad moraba con la

plenitud de la humanidad. ¿No es esto lo que sucede en la Misa cuando el pan y el vino se transforman en Cuerpo y Sangre? La Eucaristía sigue apareciendo como pan y el vino, sino que a través del milagro de la transubstanciación, tenemos la Presencia Real de Cristo.

Prestemos atención a cómo Dios se revelará a ti y vendrá a adorarlo en la Misa.
